Maturity:

55-70 days to maturity depending on the season. Generally 4-5 days later maturing than Bonsai.

Plant:

Vigorous with an erect habit. Good field holding ability with good bolt tolerance in spring. Good plant uniformity.

Disease Resistance:

HR to Club Root

Head Quality:

Head shape is typical with a strong green external colour and an excellent yellow internal colour. Good volume with an average head weight of 2-3 kg.

Harvest Season:

Spring, summer, autumn and into early winter.
