Why use a rootstock?

These rootstocks a highly resistant to **Fusarium oxysporum**, which is becoming an ever increasing problem.

Plant:

These rootstocks are reasonably vigorous and compliment the fruiting vine well. **Candystock** is the more vigorous of the three.



Superstock & Royalstock are gourd rootstocks

Fruit set, yield and flavour:

Each rootstock affects how the vine performs These varieties have been **specifically** selected to work in combination with both seedless and seeded watermelon types.

For Seedless varieties we recommend the use Royalstock and Superstock.

For Seeded varieties we recommend any of any of the above rootstocks.
