**Why use a rootstock?**

These rootstocks are highly resistant to *Fusarium oxysporum*, which is becoming an ever increasing problem.

**Plant:**

These rootstocks are reasonably vigorous and complement the fruiting vine well. **Candystock** is the more vigorous of the three.



Superstock & Royalstock are gourd rootstocks

**Fruit set, yield and flavour:**

Each rootstock affects how the vine performs. These varieties have been **specifically** selected to work in combination with both seedless and seeded watermelon types.

**For Seedless varieties we recommend the use of Royalstock and Superstock.**

**For Seeded varieties we recommend any of any of the above rootstocks.**
