#### Fruit:

Weight 1.6-2.kg with a medium small cavity. Fruit is blocky-oval in shape with sutures and a mild ropey net. Flesh has a great **melon flavour**, firm with excellent colour, brix of 12-14°. Great aroma too.

#### **Harvest Season:**

Good setting mid maturing variety. Fruit slip, but it is better to it pick earlier at the sugar cracking stage on the stem attachment.

### **Characteristics:**

Sutured melon with a mild ropey net and medium small cavity. Yields well with good fruit numbers, shipping and storage ability. Plant has good canopy cover and a strong vine. **ESL - Extended Shelf Life**

HR to Gc 1,2, Fom
