Plant:

Vigorous growing vine with good leaf cover and excellent setting ability. Short internodes For late winter and spring transplants. Early maturity.

Fruit:

Round cherry of 20-25grams. Fish bone trusses with 12-16 fruits per truss. Flesh is firm and bright red colour, excellent taste.

HR: ToMV: 0-2, Va/Vd, Fol 1-2, Ff:1-5; **IR:** Ma, Mi, Mj, TYLCV, TSWV
