Characteristics:

Suited to cool season harvest with good uniformity. Neat frame and clean butt. Dark green in colour with blister. Excellent vigour.

Head Size:

Medium large flat round head size. Good uniformity and consistent heart fill.

Harvest Season:

Suited to harvest in southern regions late Autumn to Mid Spring. Elsewhere Early Winter to early Spring harvest.

Disease Resistances:

HR to Bl 1-19,21,23

Bl - Downy mildew (*Bremia lactucae*)
