

Bazooka^{F1}



Maturity

A strong growing plant with a vigorous vine. Good fruit setting ability.

Habit:

A reasonably open plant, erect and easy to pick. Slightly more compact than Ballistic.

Fruit:

Bazooka fruit are straight and medium to dark green in colour. They grow to their length and then begin to swell evenly along the fruit. Bazooka has a small blossom end scar. High yielding variety with good shipping and storage ability.

Disease Resistances:

IR to Px
HR to ZYMV
HR to WMV

Disease Key:

Px - Powdery mildew (*Podosphaera xanthii*)
ZYMV - Zucchini Yellow Mosaic Virus
WMV - Watermelon Mosaic Virus

Harvest Season:

Bazooka is used from early season sowing during June in Northland to main season through out NZ to the end of harvest in May-June.
