Plant:

Semi erect plant habit with good curd cover.
Ibanez shows good wrap and strong leaf jacket.

Curd:

Ibanez has a white, firm curd. The shape is semi domed with medium sized dense florets.

Harvest Season:

Late autumn to early winter.

Characteristics:

A medium sized frame producing a 1.2-1.4 kg curd.

Maturity:

This variety will mature in 14-15 weeks depending in growing location and season.
