Rock melon

Fruit:

1.5- 1.8kg average weight with a small cavity. Fruit is oval in shape medium ropey net. Flesh has a great melon flavour (as a melon should be), firm with excellent colour, brix of 12-14°. Extended shelf life.

Harvest Season:

Good setting, early to mid maturing variety.

Characteristics:

Sutured melon with small cavity. Yields well with good fruit numbers. Great shipping and storage ability.

Plant has good canopy cover and a strong vine.

HR to Fom: 0,1,2, Px

Disease key:

Px— Powdery mildew (*Podosphaera xanthii*) Fom - Fusarium wilt (*Fusarium oxysporum f.*)
