

Furatto ^{F1}



Plant:

Furatto is a medium-strong vigorous plant.

Head:

Flat round head shape. Good density with a small core. Heads are well filled and heavy. When left to fully mature, **Furatto** will fill to 2.7-4kg.

Characteristics:

Furatto has strong heavy and dense leaves. Medium dark in colour with good wrapper leaves.



Harvest Season:

Suited to harvest season late spring until late autumn. This is a little dependent on location. We recommend this as the best production slot. It may run longer if required.

Maturity:

Harvest is 90 -100 days from transplant, depending on location.
 Upper North: 90 —100 days
 Lower North: 90 —120 days
 South Island: 90 — 120 days (still in trial)
